



Fiennes House

SeeAbility's Fiennes House in Wellington, Somerset, provides a rehabilitative residential service for seven visually impaired adults with complex needs seeking to explore their potential and enhance their quality of life.

Our Service

Visual impairment rehabilitation, social inclusion and quality of life are fundamental to the specialised service we provide.

We adopt a person-centred approach to support each individual to identify their own abilities, needs and preferences. After an initial assessment period, a tailored support plan is created to meet the individual's needs and enable personal outcomes to be achieved. To ensure individual control, the plan is regularly reviewed with each person and their advocates to ensure it is responsive to changing needs and wishes.

Our enabling support includes:

- ☀ A 24 hour service, including waking night provision
- ☀ Continued learning through practice of daily living and social skills
- ☀ Building confidence to make informed choices and take assessed risks
- ☀ Enabling young adults make the transition from an educational environment to an adult service and lifestyle
- ☀ Accessing community services and The Bill Cooke Activity & Resource Centre located on-site
- ☀ Assistance to access community health care services
- ☀ Maintaining and developing relationships with family and friends



At Home

Fiennes House is a single storey fully accessible home, integrating the use of colour and texture contrasts in décor and furnishings, tactile information and specialist lighting to assist visually impaired people.

The contemporary design accommodates seven individual bedrooms; five have en-suite showers, four have overhead tracking and hoists and two are adjacent to a shared bathroom with hoist.

There is an open-plan kitchen and dining area leading to a communal lounge and out into the garden. All rooms are fully furnished although individuals are welcome to bring their own belongings if they wish.

Teamwork

Our specialist service is provided by a highly trained and dedicated staff team, experienced in working with people with a visual impairment combined with other disabilities.
