# Reeves Court

LEATHERHEAD, SURREY

Residential care for people who have a severe learning disability and visual impairment.



**SeeAbility changes the lives of people who have a learning disability and a visual impairment.**



Rachel has a learning disability, visual impairment and a bilateral hearing impairment. She wore heavy glasses, which slipped down her face and pulled at her hearing aids affecting both her hearing and her sight.

When Rachel came to SeeAbility we undertook a comprehensive multi-disciplinary low vision assessment. This assessment monitored her eyesight, identified what was wrong and she was referred for ophthalmic surgery, which was carried out successfully. Rachel was given new spectacles, which had thinner lenses and were lighter. As a result she is now more comfortable, can see better, and her hearing aids stay in place. She can wear her new spectacles all the time, without taking them off to rest, because they are much more comfortable.

As a result Rachel is more confident, happier and her social interaction has improved. Her hobby of completing jigsaw puzzles has become easier and more enjoyable and she also now goes to dancing classes.

This is just one example of the way SeeAbility has focused on an individual's specific needs and been able to improve their quality of life. Even relatively small changes such as changing a pair of spectacles can make a real difference.



## Reeves Court

LEATHERHEAD, SURREY

Reeves Court is a registered care home owned and operated by SeeAbility, the UK's leading voluntary sector provider of accommodation, care and support, for people who have a learning disability and visual impairment.

The home offers a service to adults who have a severe learning disability, autism and a visual impairment, including those with challenging behaviour, physical disability, and mental health problems.

Reeves Court has a maximum occupancy of twenty five, split into four small groups. All areas are wheelchair accessible. Facilities can be made available for overnight guests. The building and garden have been designed especially for use by people with a learning disability and visual impairment, promoting safe mobility and independence.

The home is located within a ten minute walk from Leatherhead town centre and there is good access to local healthcare and educational facilities. SeeAbility's expert rehabilitation team is available to work with people to access community facilities.

A modern activity and resource centre is attached to Reeves Court offering multi sensory and low vision resources, IT facilities, business enterprise, horticultural and general activities. All areas are wheelchair accessible. The centre promotes activity in the community, including adult education, work and leisure opportunities.
