Surrey Support Service was designed to meet daily living, social and personal care needs. These are arranged through a combination of one-to-one and shared support hours.

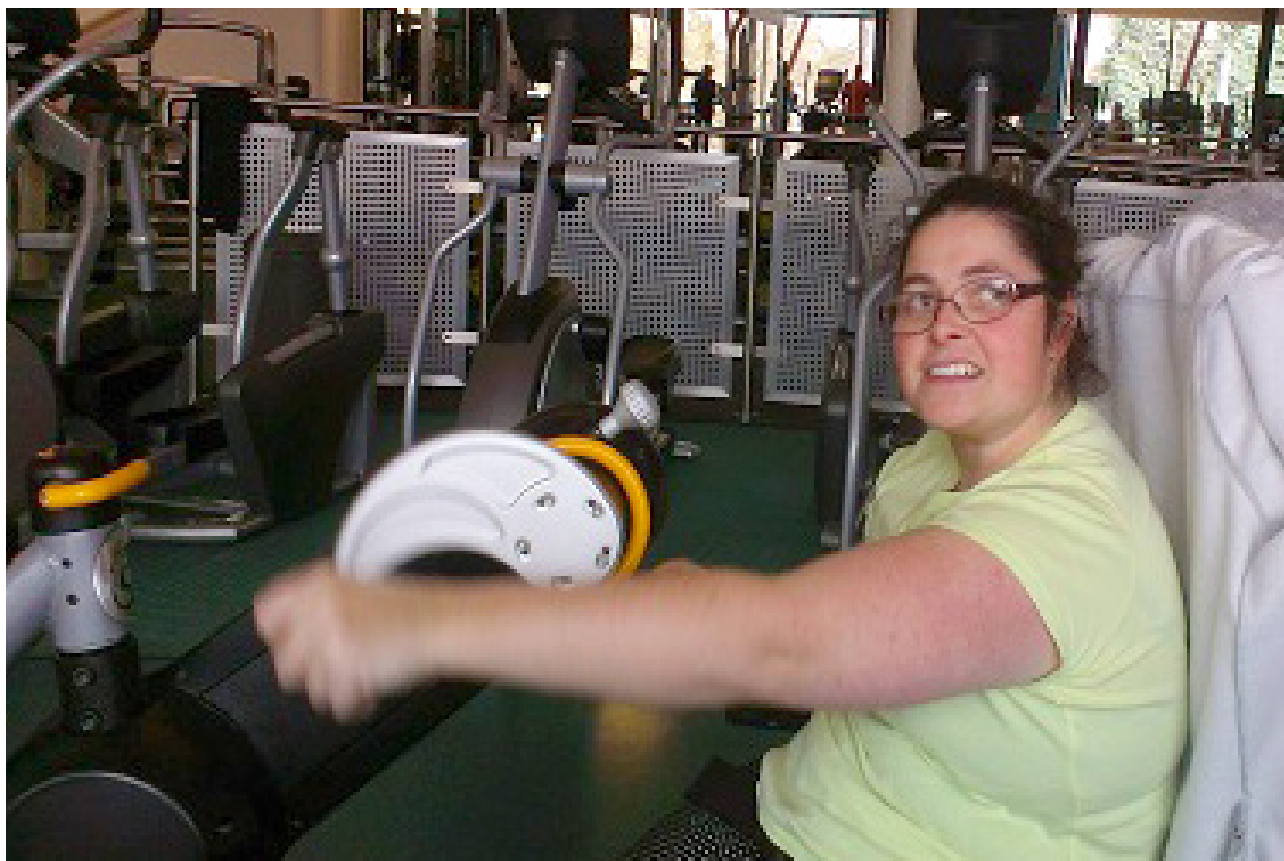
