



If you are a UK taxpayer, the Government's Gift Aid scheme means we can reclaim the tax on your donation. For example, if you donate £8 we can claim back the tax, turning your donation into £10 – at no extra cost to you!

Please remember that even if you are retired you can still give Gift Aid if you are paying tax on a savings account or investment.
