The supported living environment in Henbury features eleven spacious self-contained flats, which have been personalised to each person's unique taste. They all have large ensuite bathrooms with full accessibility features, and some contain ceiling hoists.

Our Henbury accommodation also features a quiet garden, where people can relax or get together. There is also a large car park with spaces for private vehicles.

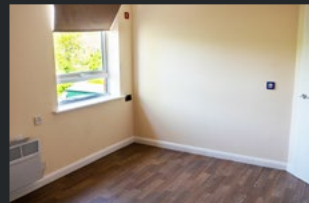
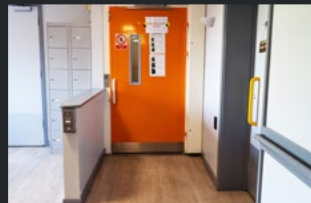

Our specialist support

SeeAbility is unique in providing in-house specialist support, including vision rehabilitation and, where commissioned, positive behaviour support (PBS).

Our focus is on encouraging people to challenge themselves to achieve their own goals and get the most out of life, while supporting increased independence and choice.

Vision rehabilitation

People with learning disabilities are ten times more likely to have sight problems, and it's vital they get the right support when they need it. The Vision Rehabilitation Team works with people who have vision impairments or sight loss to support them with increasing independence. That could be anything from learning to make a cup of tea, to learning a route to work.

Positive behaviour support

Our PBS specialists carry out functional assessments of any behaviour that is challenging a person and their team, working alongside the person supported, their family, and their support team. They work collaboratively to develop functionally equivalent skills, so the person can communicate in ways that meets their needs in a safe way.



Active support

Our teams are trained in Active Support, an approach to support that focuses on empowering people to take part in every day tasks, helping them to build their independence, confidence and skills.

This approach, across our homes, means our support is always challenging people to achieve more and take control of their lives.

Finding community in Henbury

People supported in Henbury make close friends both among their neighbours and in the local area. We have a thriving volunteer programme, with many long-term volunteers building long-term friendships with people we're supporting.

There is also plenty to do in the local area. Henbury has a modern shopping centre, Cribbs Causeway, with over 150 shops, restaurants and venues. If it's a more relaxing environment you're after, then the



grounds of Blaise Castle estate are perfect for a relaxing walk through nature.

Henbury is also very close to Bristol, with excellent transport links, so anyone can easily tap into the thriving social scene of the 'Capital of the South-West'.

There are also SeeAbility-wide programmes that people can get involved with. Our Ready, Willing and Able programme supports people to find paid employment and build careers, and the Listen Up team brings together people with disabilities to speak up about issues that matter to them.
