Accommodation

Denecroft is situated in the historic town of Guildford, known for its riverside walks, green spaces and vibrant town centre. Close to the River Wey and within easy reach of cafes, shops, theatres and parks, the setting offers a calm, welcoming place to live alongside plenty of opportunities to socialise and enjoy everyday life.

Denecroft has two bedrooms on the ground floor, and four on the first floor, accessible via stairs. Bedrooms are fully furnished and comfortable, with alarm call facilities in place for peace of mind. The building also includes shared kitchen, dining and living areas.



The house also has a communal garden, providing a peaceful outdoor space to enjoy throughout the year. The environment is designed to feel safe and homely, supporting people to relax and make the space their own.

Based in a residential neighbourhood, Denecroft ensures that people feel part of their local community. With support from a kind, experienced team, people are encouraged to build friendships, welcome friends and family, take part in activities and pursue their interests.

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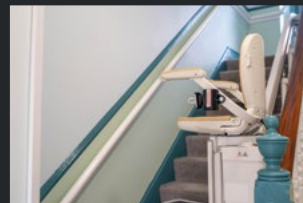
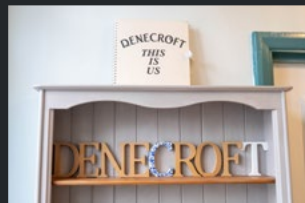
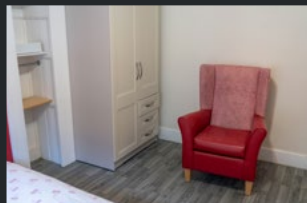

Our specialist support

SeeAbility is unique in providing in-house specialist support, including vision rehabilitation and, where commissioned, positive behaviour support (PBS).

Our focus is on encouraging people to challenge themselves to achieve their own goals and get the most out of life, while supporting increased independence and choice.

Vision rehabilitation

People with learning disabilities are ten times more likely to have sight problems, and it's vital they get the right support when they need it. The Vision Rehabilitation Team works with people who have vision impairments or sight loss to support them with increasing independence. That could be anything from learning to make a cup of tea, to learning a route to work.

Positive behaviour support

Our PBS specialists carry out functional assessments of any behaviour that is challenging a person and their team, working alongside the person supported, their family, and their support team. They work collaboratively to develop functionally equivalent skills, so the person can communicate in ways that meets their needs in a safe way.



Active support

90% of our teams are trained in Active Support, an approach to support that focuses on empowering people to take part in every day tasks, helping them to build their independence, confidence and skills.

This approach, across our homes, means our support is always challenging people to achieve more and take control of their lives.

Finding community at Denecroft

People living in Denecroft are supported to build strong connections and friendships, both within their home and in the wider area of Guildford. Every day at Denecroft is an opportunity to try something new, with people encouraged to pursue their own interests and hobbies in ways that feel right for them.

Being based in Guildford means there is plenty to enjoy locally. People are supported to spend time in the town centre, whether that's catching up with friends over a coffee, visiting the local shops or enjoying riverside walks along the River Wey. There are also opportunities to go to the local cinema, enjoy live performances at G Live, and relax in one of the many parks close to the home.

Many people at Denecroft enjoy being active in their community, whether it be taking part in further education, swimming at the local pool, getting creative in the garden or joining a local club. Others enjoy the excitement of attending football matches, as well as planning day trips and holidays.



There are also SeeAbility-wide programmes that people can choose to get involved with, including Listen Up!, our advocacy programme which brings people with disabilities together to speak up about issues that matter to them. Through these opportunities, people at Denecroft are supported to be active members of both their local community and SeeAbility as a whole.
